The purpose of the Collector's School at the David C. Driskell Center is to provide training and education to new and established collectors about the lifetime process of building an art collection. The Collector's School focuses on collecting African American art, but the provided and demonstrated advices and skills may be used by anyone interested in collecting art and supporting the arts.

The David C. Driskell Center held its First Annual Collector's School in 2016 and its Second Collector's School in 2017; both were fully attended and well received. Due to that success, the Driskell Center is pleased to announce that it will present its Third Annual Collector's School. It will be held from the evening of Friday, November 16<sup>th</sup> to Sunday afternoon, November 18<sup>th</sup>, 2018 and will focus on the following themes, among others:

- An Introduction to the History of African American Art
- The World of Collecting and Collector Responsibilities
- Understanding the Business of Art, Where to Buy, and How to Get Started
- Managing, Cataloging, and Caring for Your Collection
- Estate Planning

The Collector's School will be held at the David C. Driskell Center at the University of Maryland College Park campus and is limited to 30 participants; the fee to participate in the Collector's School is \$300 per person. Registration is accepted for the full weekend only. Upon completion of the School, students will be given a bibliography of suggested reading materials and a Certificate of Completion.
