Abstract:

The Michael D. Harris Collection was compiled and organized by Michael D. Harris over the course of his career and documents his contributions to African American art history as an artist, scholar, curator, and educator. The collection measures approximately 26 linear feet with an additional 90GB of digital files. Materials date from 1829-2022, and a majority fall between 1970-2010. Major focus points of the collection include Harris's art career, both his personal work and his membership in the artist collective African Commune of Bad Relevant Artists (AfriCOBRA); his prolific scholarship as a renowned art historian; and his years as a professor of art history at various universities. Material formats include correspondence, interview tapes and transcripts, photographic prints, field notes from Harris's study in Nigeria, publications and manuscripts, curatorial records, newspaper clippings, and AfriCOBRA meeting minutes.

Acquisition Information

The Michael D. Harris Collection was donated to The Driskell Center Archives by the estate of Michael D. Harris. Archives staff collected materials during the Fall of 2022 from his home in Atlanta, Georgia. The Deed of Gift was finalized in October 2022.

Separated Materials

The Michael D. Harris Collection is held in the The Driskell Center Archives at the University of Maryland, College Park. Materials that are oversized or restricted for any reason have been separated from the collection and housed in boxes adjacent to the main collection.

Processing Information

The collection was arranged and described to the folder level by The Driskell Center Archives staff and interns. Processing began in 2023 and was completed in June 2025. All paper materials are housed in acid-free folders and acid-free boxes. Photographs are housed in polyester sleeves, photo slides in acid-free slide boxes, and audiovisual materials in specialized plastic enclosures. All metal fasteners were replaced with plastic paper clips.

Biographical Note

Michael DeHart Harris (1948-2022) was a distinguished scholar and artist whose work across both academic and fine arts institutions was instrumental to the development of African and African American Art as fields of study, criticism, and artistic practice. Harris was a scholar of the Yoruba language and was known to some by his Yoruba name “Olúṣínà,” which means “the Lord opens the way.”

Born in Cleveland, Ohio, on July 14, 1948, Harris developed an interest in art from a young age. He took Saturday classes at the Cleveland Museum and frequented the Cleveland Art Institute. Though he initially excelled in athletics, Harris ultimately dedicated his focus to artmaking.

An all-city shortstop, Harris enrolled at Bowling Green State University in 1966 to play baseball and earned a BA in Education. He went on to earn an MFA in Painting from Howard University (1979), an MA in African American Studies from Yale University (1989), and an MA, MPhil, and PhD in Art History, also from Yale (1996). His dissertation titled “Contemporary Yoruba Art in Ile-Ife: History, Continuum, Motive, and Transformation” (1996), explored the link between traditional and contemporary art in Nigeria and was based on a number of interviews he conducted in Ile-Ife in the early 90s. Many of these interviews are included in the Michael D. Harris Collection.

Harris's art practice encompassed painting, mixed media, textiles, photography, and poetry. His artwork has been featured in exhibitions in the United States, Europe, and the Caribbean. Additionally, he was a longtime member of the Black artists group, AfriCOBRA, or the African Commune of Bad Relevant Artists.

As a lecturer, professor, and curator, Harris worked at a variety of cultural and higher education institutions including the High Museum of Art, the Harvey Gantt African American Cultural Center, Morehouse College, Spelman College, Duke University, and the University of North Carolina – Chapel Hill. In 2020, Harris retired as Associate Professor Emeritus from Emory University, where he taught art history in the African American Studies Department beginning in 2007.

Harris's scholarship mined the connections between African art traditions and contemporary American art and examined the formation and impact of racialized images on American visual culture. He was a respected contemporary of David C. Driskell, who once wrote to him, “Seldom do I have a chance to talk with someone who is on the same wave-length art historically and with the depth of understanding in the field as you have.”

Historical Note (AfriCOBRA)

The African Commune of Bad Relevant Artists (AfriCOBRA) was established in 1968 on the South Side of Chicago by artists Jeff Donaldson, Jae Jarrell, Wadsworth Jarrell, Barbara Jones-Hogu, Nelson Stevens, and Gerald Williams. Founded at the height of the Black Arts Movement, the group worked toward defining a “Black aesthetic” that would

represent Black artists, celebrate African diasporic identity, and highlight the political struggles of Black Americans. Each of the founding artists contributed to the renowned *Wall of Respect* (1967), a mural in Bronzeville, Chicago, that depicted Black historical and cultural icons and immediately became a landmark of Black art and liberation during the Black Arts Movement. The Wall of Respect was lost after a fire damaged its building and the structure was demolished, but it inspired a mural arts movement across both Chicago and the country.

AfriCOBRA developed a 1969 manifesto, “Ten in Search of a Nation” and a 1970 exhibition at Studio Museum in Harlem of the same name. This hallmark show broke them out of Chicago and introduced AfriCOBRA to a national audience. They gave group exhibitions at Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs) throughout the 1970s and in 2018 celebrated their 50th anniversary with their retrospective, “AfriCOBRA: Now”.

Scope and Contents

The Michael D. Harris Collection documents his work as an art historian, artist, and educator in seven series cataloged to the folder level. It features research, notes, and publication information for Harris's respected and prolific art historical career, exhibition materials for his own artwork, prints of his photographs, and both artist and exhibition information related to his membership in AfriCOBRA.

The collection is arranged into seven series, each with constituent subseries. The first five series are paper-based and the final two series are devoted to photographic (Series 6) and audiovisual materials (Series 7).

Series Description/Container Listing

The following describes the content within the Michael D. Harris Collection to the folder level. Oversized or special format materials were separated from sequence and placed in oversized or format-specific boxes. Boxes 38 and 39 are oversized boxes, and boxes 40-45 contain photo slides or audiovisual materials. The Collection contains 90GB of digital material, noted with “digital” as its box number. Some digital material is not described in the Finding Aid; researchers looking for specific information should consult with Archives staff.

Series 1: Person and Artist, 1974-2019

The records in this series are divided into eight subseries relating to Harris's art practice and personal life. Harris maintained an active, multimodal artmaking practice in oil painting, mixed media collage, textiles, and mural arts throughout his career, and all are represented in the collection's exhibition ephemera and news clippings. Alongside coverage of his visual work is a collection of poems, short stories, chapbooks, and photographs, as well as early artist statements. With many materials dating to the 1970s, this series conveys Harris's stylistic progression and philosophical outlook as he navigated the art world and provides an intimate keyhole into his emotional and intellectual life.
